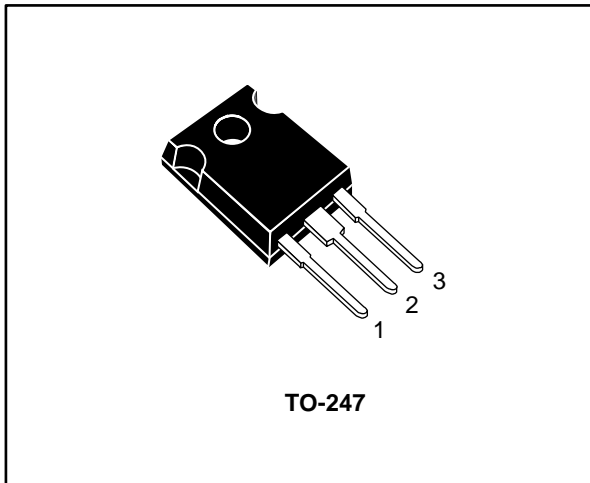
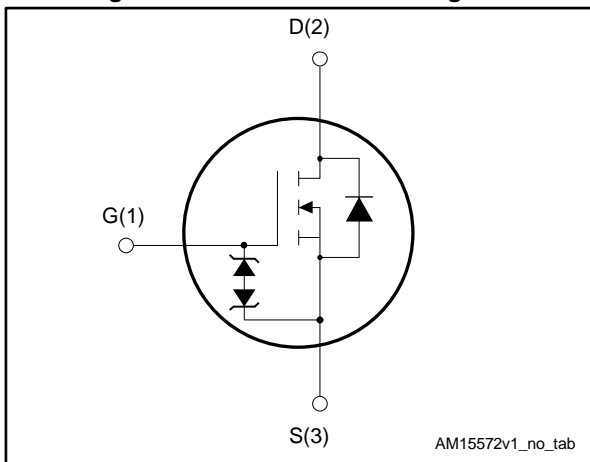


Figure 1: Internal schematic diagram

### Description

This high voltage N-channel Power MOSFET is part of the MDmesh™ DM2 fast recovery diode series. It offers very low recovery charge ( $Q_{rr}$ ) and time ( $t_{rr}$ ) combined with low  $R_{DS(on)}$ , rendering it suitable for the most demanding high efficiency converters and ideal for bridge topologies and ZVS phase-shift converters.

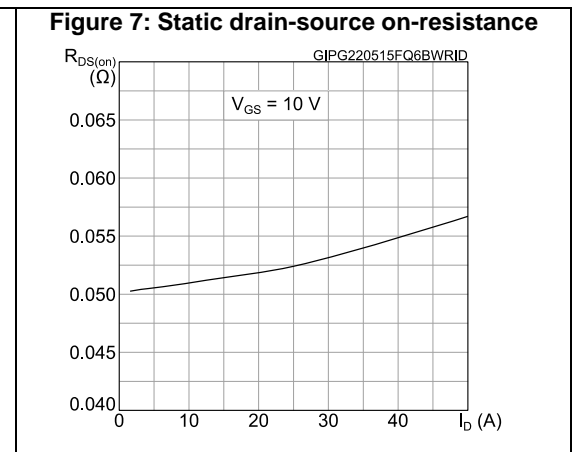
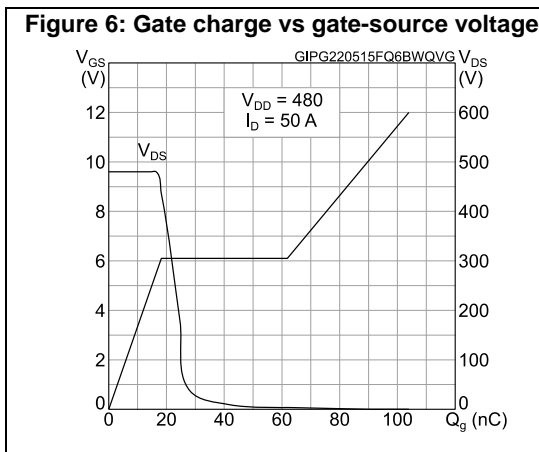
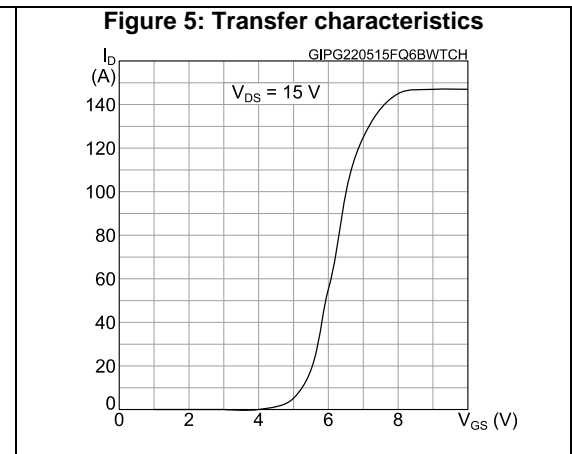
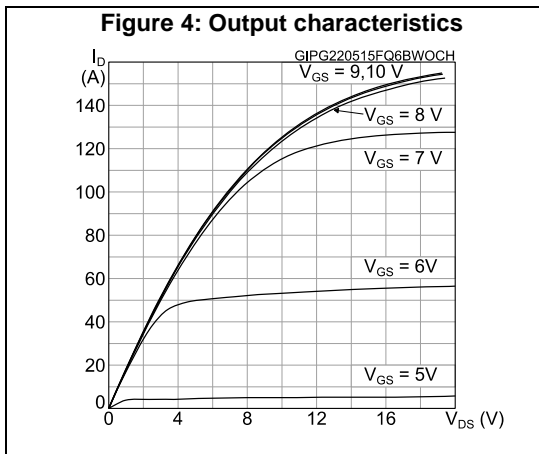
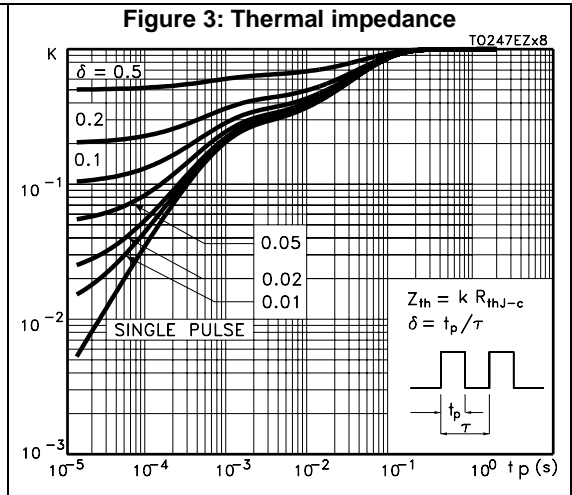
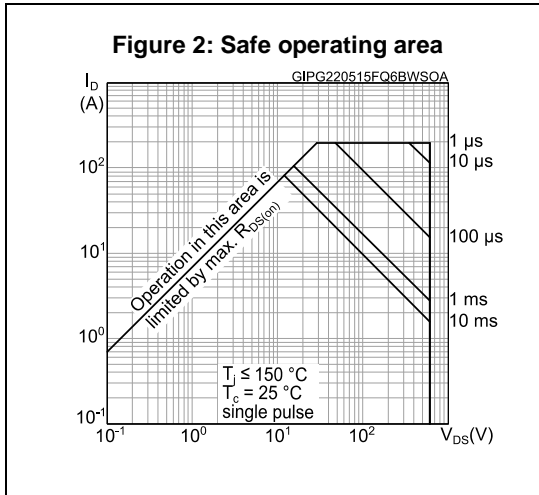


Figure 8: Capacitance variations

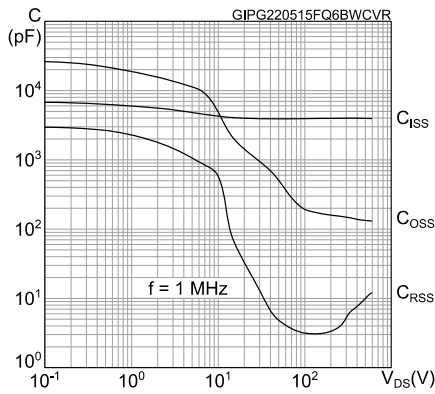


Figure 9: Normalized gate threshold voltage vs temperature

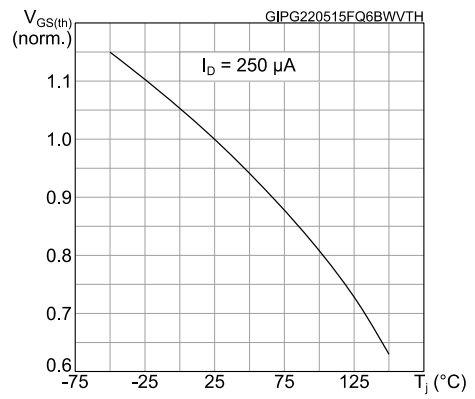


Figure 10: Normalized on-resistance vs temperature

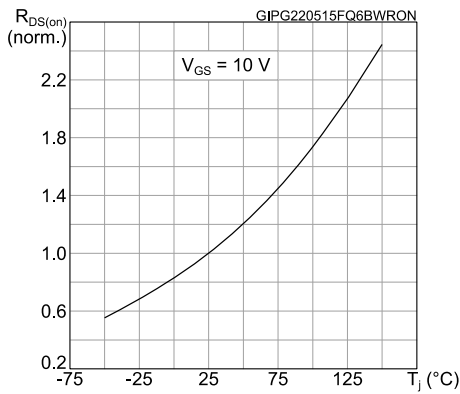


Figure 11: Normalized V(BR)DSS vs temperature

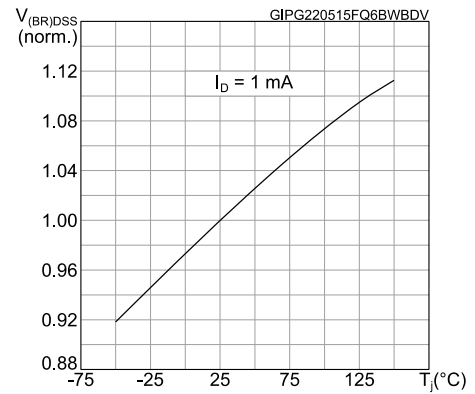


Figure 12: Output capacitance stored energy

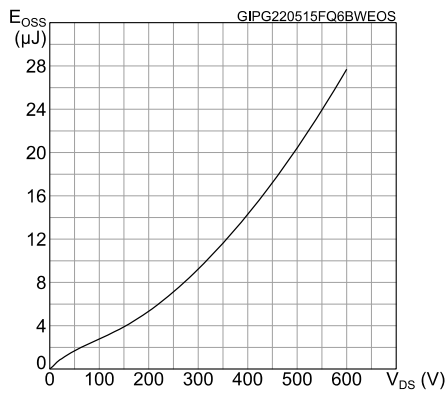
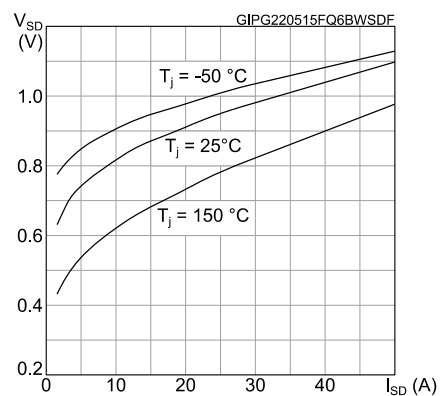
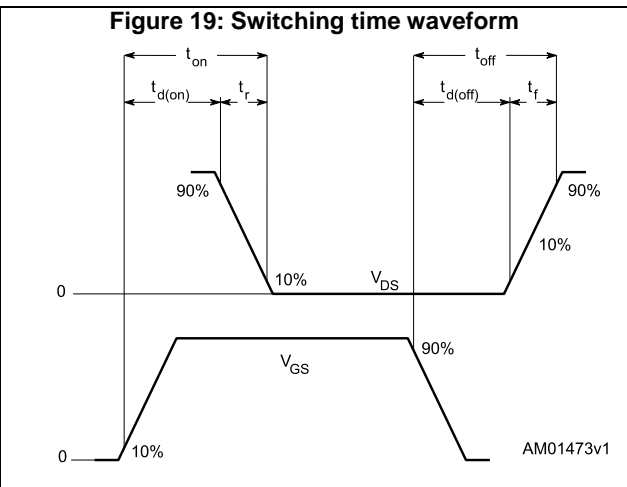
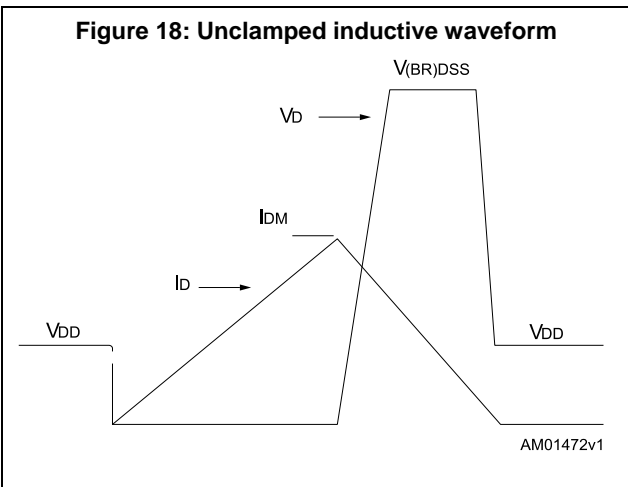
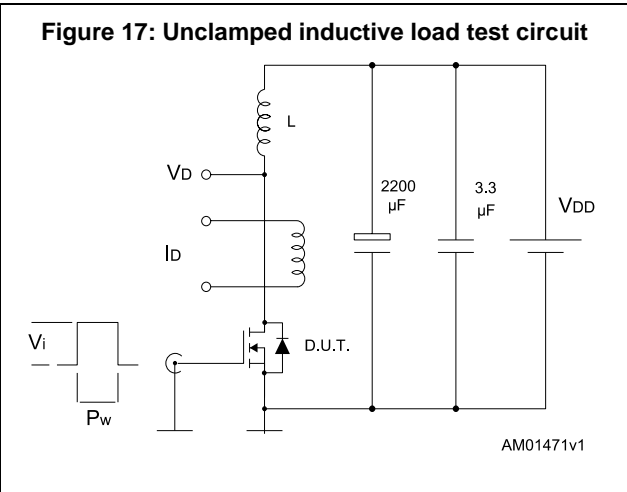
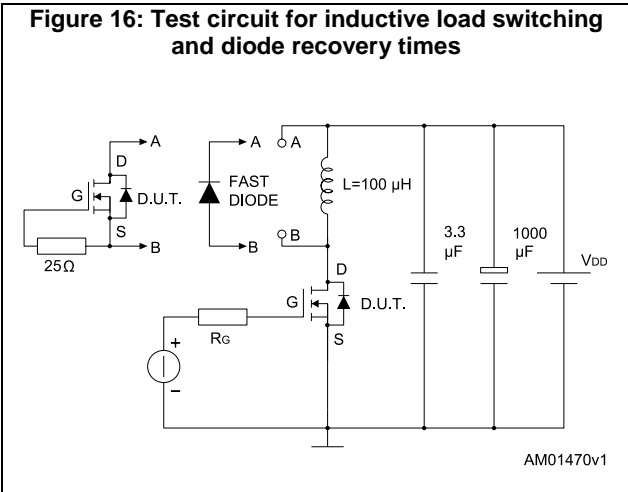
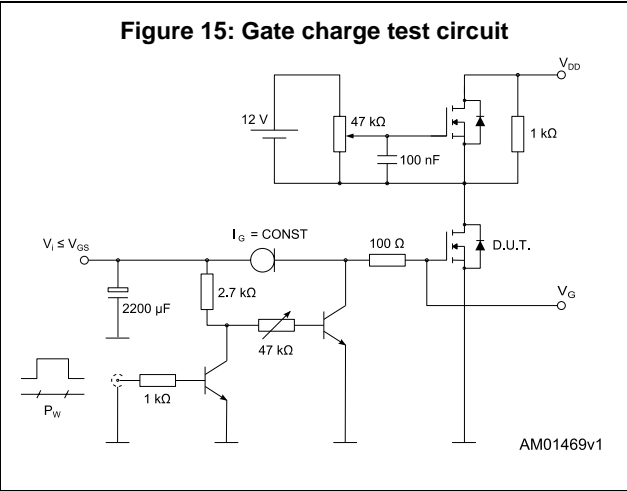


Figure 13: Source-drain diode forward characteristics

Figure 20: TO-247 package outline

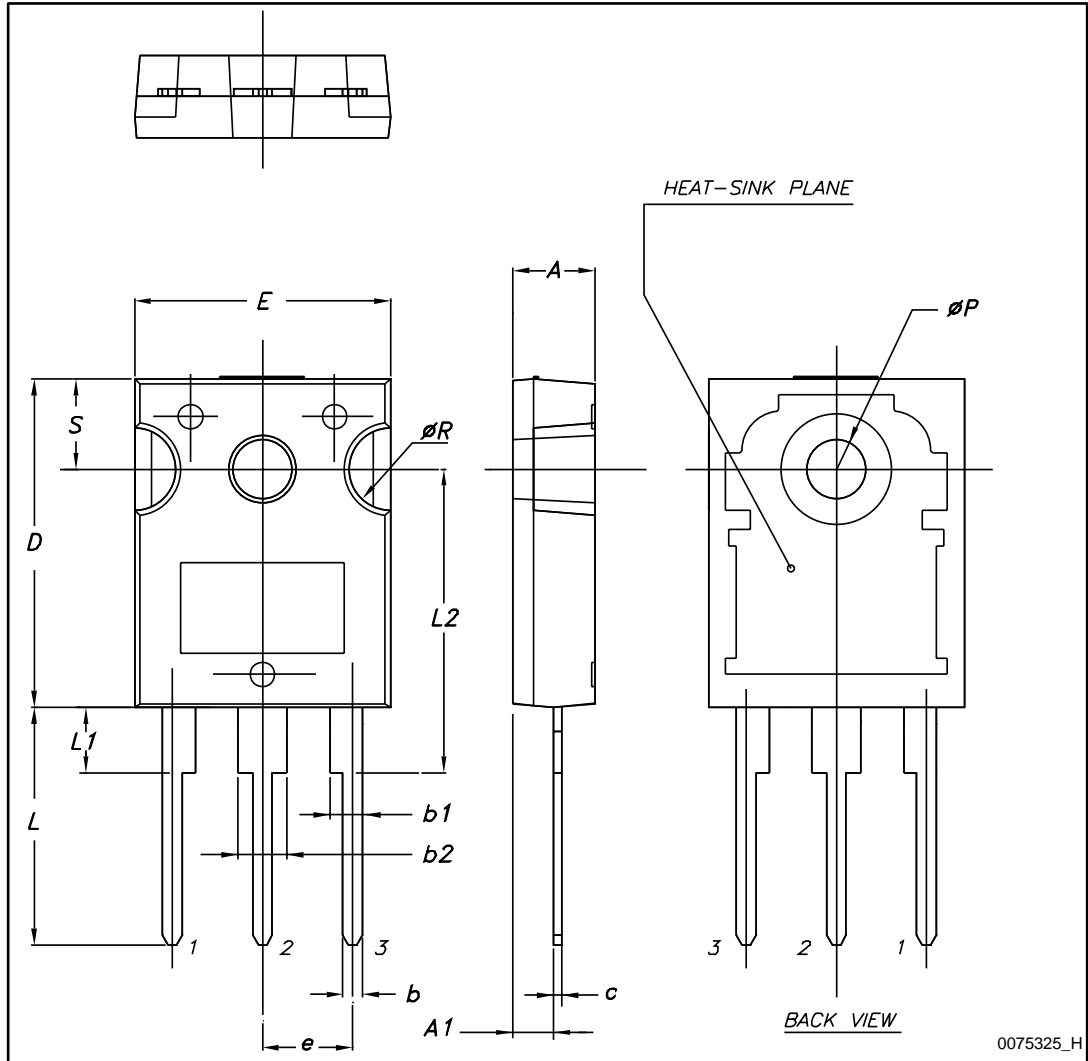
