Component Location on Pad



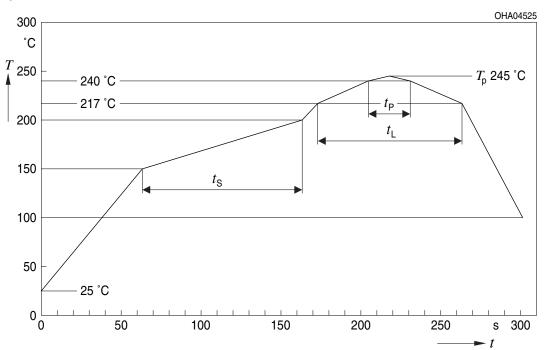
